Publish

- Publish an original research paper or abstract in a residency newsletter
- Publish an op-ed in a local or state newspaper explaining the meaning and significance of a current public health concern
- Publish a letter to the editor of a national medical journal analyzing results of a paper published

Present

- Present a report of original research in local/state grand rounds or in a residency conference
- Present a case study and literature review of a clinical problem in local/state grand rounds
- Present the design and results of a clinical quality improvement project conducted in the residency practice in a residency conference
- Serve as chair of local or state medical society committee; publish a report of that committee's accomplishments in a medical society newsletter

Create

- Lead a local or state patient education conference series on care for a chronic condition
- Describe the design, implementation, and effects of a patient education program on risk behavior or chronic disease management in a residency newsletter
- Prepare an enduring curriculum for use in a residency program: conduct needs assessment, prepare objectives, activities, and evaluation, conduct and summarize results of a pilot implementation; present to the residency faculty for incorporation into ongoing curriculum
- Develop and implement a program for patient self-care for chronic disease; present the outcomes in residency conference and publish a summary report in a residency newsletter
- Prepare and present to faculty and peers a lecture on topic of interest based on a needs assessment and including goals, objectives, and evaluation.
