

Education Records Formal Hearing Request

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) affords a student the opportunity to request a formal hearing if their request to amend their student record is denied. The hearing will be conducted by a university official who does not have a direct interest in the outcome of the hearing. Please see the PNWU FERPA policy for the definition of education records.
